

WHAT DOES YOUR ALDER-PERSON DO FOR YOU?

- Vote on liquor licenses, building permits and special use permits (including Social Equity Marijuana Dispensary Permits)
- Vote on budgets for public services including Aurora Police and Fire Departments, public housing, community services, and more.
- Vote on city infrastructure investments, city contracts, new ordinances and ordinance amendments.
- Promote city resources to residents
- Work with constituents to address their ward concerns
- And so much more

Typically your first non-emergency phone call for local city government issues should be directed toward your ward alder-person.

AURORA HAS FIVE STANDING-COMMITTEES WITH ALDER-PERSON MEMBERS

These committees address specific issues and routine city business before bringing them to the Committee of the Whole (City Council). (Note: Meetings online may change, check the city website for info: www.aurora-il.org)

- Building, Zoning, and Economic Development (BZE) | Meets online, 4 PM, 2nd & 4th Wednesday of each month
- Infrastructure and Technology (I&T) | Meets online, 4 PM, 2nd & 4th Monday of each month
- Rules, Administration, and Procedures (RAP) | Meets online, 3 PM, 1st & 3rd Tuesday of each month
- Finance Committee | Meets online, 3 PM, 2nd & 4th Thursday of each month
- Public Health, Safety and Transportation (PHST) | Meets online, 4 PM, 2nd & 4th Tuesday of each month

VOTER TURNOUT FOR AURORA ALDERMANIC ELECTIONS*

2019**

- Total 5,581 voted
- Total registered voters = 86,549
- Roughly 6% of registered voters cast a ballot in 2019 for the Aurora aldermanic elections

2017

- Total 12,783 voted
- Total registered voters = 64,607
- Roughly 19% of registered voters cast a ballot in 2017 for the Aurora aldermanic elections
